



## JOB DESCRIPTION

Note: This job description is for information only and reflects the main tasks to be carried out by the Junior Road Safety Officer.

<b>Post Title:</b>	Junior Road Safety Officer
<b>School:</b>	
<b>Responsible to:</b>	Junior Road Safety Officer Co-ordinator and Head Teacher
<b>Purpose of Post:</b>	To encourage other students to act responsibly on or near roads; to increase road safety awareness for everyone in school; to organise road safety activities and encourage the involvement of other children.

### Main Tasks:

1. To create and maintain a road safety notice board, with relevant information for each term.
2. To arrange and carry out road safety activities/ competitions/ surveys/ etc. with help from the information sent to you by the Junior Road Safety Officer Co-ordinator.
3. To read school assembly messages in agreement with the headteacher.
4. Use the information in the JRSO pack and the JRSO website [www.junior-rso.org.uk](http://www.junior-rso.org.uk) to develop road safety awareness to everyone within your school.
5. To become a good JRSO representative for your school by setting an example of good road safety practice .
